

## NOMINATION PROCESS 2025

I hope this finds you well.

I am writing to provide you with important information regarding our semester from August to December.

1. Please submit the official nomination list to me by **May 10th (in Excel format and attached to the email)**, with the following information:

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2. The nominated student is responsible for registering on **DreamApply** at <https://anahuac-exchange.dreamapply.com/> and initiating the application process.
3. Once the student has been nominated, the process will be continued in our DreamApply platform in order to elaborate the learning agreement. All available courses can be accessed on DreamApply.
4. Anáhuac receives the application forms through DreamApply **until June 10th**.
5. Anahuac will send the students an official acceptance email with the acceptance letter attached and, later an official welcome email.

### VISA

Students are generally permitted to remain in the country for a period of 180 days with an FMT (Forma Migratoria Turista) – tourist format, which they receive on the aircraft prior to landing in Mexican territory. ## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS

### TEACHING

Each School, according to the profile of its courses, will determine, if these can be offered on-site, distance-learning, or online mode and eventually alternate between these modes.

### COURSE SELECTION

Exchange students must inform which program at our University they wish to enroll in. For the gastronomy program, they must register for at least 75% of the courses they intend to take within that program. If schedules allow, they may enroll the remaining 25% in courses from other programs.

Students who are coming to Cancun this semester will be able to select courses from semesters 1, 3, 5, 7, and 9, as shown in each study plan.

In the case of International Business, all courses from semesters 1 to 5 will be available for exchange students, while all courses from semesters 1 to 3 in the case of Strategic Business Management.

### STUDENTS INTERESTED IN MEDICINE

Please be informed that you may enroll in courses from semesters 1 to 4 without any complications. However, beginning in the fifth semester, students are required to complete theoretical coursework in the classroom and practical training in a hospital setting. As a result, availability at hospitals will be a determining factor. You must consult with your coordinator at Anáhuac before making this decision.

### FOR YOUR CONSIDERATION

Courses in cooking, mixology, wine tasting, and similar subjects require supplies. Although there is no fee for the course itself, students are responsible for the cost of the necessary supplies. The same applies to activities such as snorkeling, diving, and other sports; while there is no charge for the course, students must pay for the rental of equipment if needed.

### ACCOMODATION

The residence CASA GRANDE is within walking distance of the campus. Residents at CASA GRANDE have access to a gym, a swimming pool, and common and study areas. They also have the option to prepare their own meals or dine at the on-site restaurant.
