- Create an account using a current, valid email address* and then select the appropriate program using the “**University of Waterloo - International Agreements Application.**” **Please do NOT use any qq.com email addresses.*
- The total application fee is **\$85.00 in Canadian funds**, payable to the Ontario Universities’ Application Centre upon completing your online application.

Arrange to have all your official documents, transcripts and English language test results sent to us.

Required documents for your application must be received by Waterloo no later than **March 16, 2026**.

- A printed copy of your completed application form with your institution's nomination signature/approval.
- A current official university transcript with a certified English language translation. If your transcript does NOT indicate your current course enrollment, you must include a letter (preferably from your advisor) listing your current courses.
- If your 2nd year grades are not available by the deadline, please submit them as soon as possible)
- You can upload unofficial documents directly to us using Quest: uwaterloo.ca/quest/help/students/how-do-i/application-documents
- Write the English Language Proficiency (ELP) test administered by Renison University College to qualify for the summer iEFAS program, or
- Submit an official English language test score as outlined on Waterloo's English Language Requirements website: uwaterloo.ca/future-students/admissions/english-language-requirements

Sending Your Official Documents

We cannot make an admission decision if we do not have all your documents.

Your university must mail to Waterloo or give directly to a Waterloo representative your transcripts and certified translation, in a stamped and sealed envelope.
